

JANUARY TERM 2010 HELD ON 16TH DAY OF MARCH 2010

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment March 15, 2010. Present Sean O'Brien, Presiding Commissioner Jim Mayes, Associate Commissioner District #1, and Matt Bass, Commissioner District 2, and Elaine Luck, County Clerk, and the following proceedings were had:

IN RE: JIM VOLMERT, AUDITOR

Jim Volmert, Auditor, met with the County Commission and reported that he has contacted wholesalers to purchase three police cars. Jim Volmert said that he has received one bid and will contact two others before selling the cars.

Jim Volmert, Auditor, asked since the county has gone second class the Presiding Commissioner determines who the budget officer and wanted to confirm that Elaine Luck, County Clerk was appointed. Sean O'Brien said yes. Jim Volmert said that he felt that was a good choice. Jim Volmert asked when do you want to meet with him. The County Commission asked him to meet with them on the first Monday of each month at 11:00 a.m.

IN RE: PAULA GOUGH, MoDOT DISTRICT ENGINEER, & IRVIN FACKLER, MoDOT ENGINEER

Paula Gough, MoDOT District Engineer, and Irvin Fackler, MoDOT Engineer, met with the County Commission and discussed issues regarding lettering of state roads. The County Commission brought up roads used as a detour when flooding occurs to get to Highway 47. The County Commission explained that there are short spans of roads that are still gravel and that the county has applied for solid waste grant to finish hard surfacing these roads for the last two years. The County Commission asked if there was any way the state could help on flood relief roads due to the anticipated floods for this spring.. Paula Gough said that they would look at flood relief roads.

Paula Gough explained the restraints that MoDOT is having with funding currently. Paula Gough asked if the county would consider taking over a short amount of state road down by Moscow Mills by the storage units.

G. John Richards, P.A., met with the County Commission and discussed statement sent to school districts regarding SRO's. G. John Richards, P.A., said statements will be sent as soon as the sheriff's department sends him information.
