Use only the pen provided.</p> <p>CANDIDATES: To vote for person, whose name is printed on the ballot, darken the oval to the left of the name of the person for whom you wish to vote.</p> <p>WRITE-IN: To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write his or her name in the blank space provided for such purposes and darken the oval to the left of the space. Only a declared write-in candidate is to be counted.</p> <p>PROPOSITIONS or QUESTIONS: If you are in favor of the proposition or question darken the oval opposite the word "YES". If you are opposed to the proposition or question, darken the oval opposite the word "NO".</p> <p>SPOILED BALLOT: If you spoil the ballot or make an error, you may return it to an election judge and receive another.
